The Chalet at Twin Farms, Barnard, Vermont

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"Winter is not a season," Sinclair Lewis once said. "It's an occupation." New England winters can indeed seem an endless chore, but Valentine's Day at [Twin Farms](#)—a country retreat set on the Nobel Prize-winning author's former Vermont estate—is all about warmth and comfort. Spanning 300 acres of ponds, forests, and meadows, the resort welcomes guests with a collection of 20 rooms, suites, and cottages, the most exquisite of which is the **Chalet**. Accessible via a private drive, the 3,000-square-foot dwelling sits at the edge of one of Twin Farms' six ski trails. Once a modest log cabin, the retreat is now a romantic one-bedroom masterpiece featuring a dining nook, a library, and an expansive sunken living room with a floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace. Throughout the Chalet, massive windows overlook miles of rolling hills and forests, as do several patios and verandas, one of which includes a ceramic hot tub.
