### FRESH-BAKED COOKIES

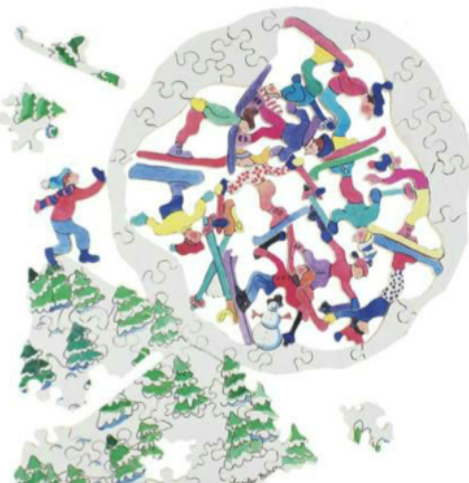
**Waldorf Astoria Park City, Utah**

## The Distillery Inn Carbondale, Colo.

Never slept in a distillery (at least on purpose)? Here's your chance. Carbondale's Marble Distilling Co. is the first distillery in the world with a full-service luxury hotel under its roof. So now you can, essentially, sleep with the stills.

The Distillery Inn serves up five king rooms with fireplaces and private balconies boasting views of snow-tipped Mount Sopris. Down in the Marble Bar, sample the distillery's smooth Marble Vodka, filtered through crushed Yule marble from Colorado's Elk Mountains. Grab a small bite at the bar, then head out to one of Carbondale's many restaurants before returning to the distillery for a Gingercello nightcap.
