Also in La Jolla, nine major beneficiaries including Arc of San Diego and Old Globe Theatre received grant checks from the 2015 Jewel Ball Magnifique—totaling a staggering \$870,933—during the **Las Patronas Beneficiary Luncheon** held at the Marine Room. The celebration was especially spirited as Las Patronas also rang in its 70th anniversary. Meanwhile in Rancho Sante Fe, it was East-meets-best at Rancho Valencia during the **Relais & Châteaux Chef Collaboration** dinner. Chef Nathan Rich of Vermont's Twin Farms and Executive Chef Jarrod Moiles of Rancho Valencia teamed up for an intimate five-course feast highlighting East Coast faves like Maine lobster and artisan Vermont cheese. Across the bridge, it was fitting that the longest-running philanthropic event in San Diego was held at the equally iconic Hotel Del. Heart of Gold was the theme of **Rady Children's Hospital Foundation's 107th Annual Charity Ball**, where guests gathered in the Crown Room to honor Evelyn and Ernest Rady and raise money for the crisis stabilization unit at the hospital. Meanwhile, the **Women's Auxiliary of Seacrest Village Retirement Communities** held its 38th annual gala, themed Silver Screen, at the Hyatt Regency La Jolla. More than 350 guests were in attendance, and the event raised more than \$450,000 to provide charitable care for residents in need of funding for housing and healthcare. 


